GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2017 MSSA Awards Banquet Shoot is a registered tournament and will be run in accordance with the rules of the National Skeet Shooting Association.

Prairie Grove Shotgun Sports will host a dinner for all contestants and their guests on Saturday night, following shootoffs. There is no charge for shooters' dinner; guests' dinner fee is \$15. Please confirm dinner reservations by Monday, April 17. **Call Mary Ann at 573.999.3457 or email mgates@socket.net for reservations.**

Doubles title event will be 100 targets total with 50 targets on Saturday and 50 targets on Sunday. One-day shooters will have their doubles registered as an additional targets, \$18.50 per 50, without purse.

5-person squads will be used. One-gun shooters may shoot their event at any time prior to and including last flight scheduled for that event. Scores will not be posted until following the first flight of the event.

Gun Champion will come out of class. Ties will be settled by shootoff, stations 3-4-5, miss and out by stations, fair pair.

Shoot management reserves the right to change the program. Changes will be posted at the registration desk. Shoot management reserves the right to cause the withdrawal of any contestant who, in the sole opinion of shoot management, endangers or annoys other contestants or spectators or otherwise disrupts the harmony of the tournament.
